a number of Jews fled to a place that seemed illogical but open. Just before the Germans began to systematically kill Jews in large numbers, they found a place of refuge in Shanghai, China. Inspired by a showing of the movie at her synagogue, Tikvah

As Nazi persecution became more prevalent in the late 1930s,

Group president Helayne Levy suggested that Hadassah Southern California hold a movie night to play Shanghai Ghetto, a 2002 movie highlighting the flight of 20,000 Jews to Shanghai after World War II. Another member, Giselle Dunst, suggested that the group get a speaker who is a refugee from the ghetto.

A neighbor who was born in Shanghai referred Giselle to Austrian-born renowned speaker and Life Member Trixie Wachsner. Trixie immigrated to Shanghai during World War II and was forced to move as a stateless refugee to the Hongkew Ghetto. She donated her time to speak to the Hadassah members.

Marge Chirchick got the idea to partner with Gina Raphael, whose daughter, Sydney, was soon to have her Bat Mitzvah. Born in a city near Shanghai, Sydney was searching for a Bat Mitzvah project that connected with Israel and also linked back to China.

Sydney, who speaks Hebrew, Chinese and English, has attended Jewish Day School throughout, and finding ways to connect with Israel are a focus for both her and her family. A life member of Hadassah, Sydney was thrilled to support this event and meet Trixie. The screening became Sydney's Bat Mitzvah project, and she raised more than \$1,000!
