Kesher Monday Program

Ages 5 - 13, 4:00 - 5:30pm

Kesher Hebrew School's Monday curriculum for all age groups includes **Tefilla/Prayer** using Hillel's innovative Tefilah curriculum and kid friendly illustrated siddurim (prayer books) designed by Koren Publishers.

Kriah/Hebrew Reading includes Ivrit (spoken Hebrew). Students are split by level from beginner Alef Bet learners until Hebrew language learners using motivational strategies to endear children to Hebrew.

Torah Explorers

Age appropriate curriculum varies for each group. Our younger students will begin learning the stories and lessons of our forefathers in the book of Bereishit and Shemot using the multiple intelligences teaching method (dress up, drama, projects, song and games).

Bar/Bat Mitzvah Adventure

The popular Bat Mitzvah Program aims to prepare girls in grade 6+ for the exciting journey to Jewish womanhood by taking each girl on a journey through the cycle of Jewish life. We also offer a Bar Mitzvah class in which boys will prepare for their initiation into Jewish manhood by exploring their identity as Jews through the lens of Jewish history. They will focus on practical mitzvot (commandments) by participating in activities such as tying tzitzit and teffilin knots. Students who wish to read from the Torah will have a special course in the Taamei Hamikra tailored to the student's Parasha. Both Bar and Bat Mitzvah students will have the option of celebrating their special day with the Hillel community on Shabbat.
